## Community Project



**AIM:** To work as a team, contributing to a community resource by helping out with repair or decoration works, fundraising initiatives or other projects that aid development or solve a particular problem.

**FORMAT:** Once we have established which sort of project – environmental, refurbishment, social/entertainment, conservation or other – that you would like to be involved with, we will match your group with an appropriate project within your area. On the day, our event managers will work with small teams (or the group as a whole) to manage the schedule, allocating equipment, tasks and resources as required and overseeing the progress of the project. Regular reviews and de-briefs ensure that learning opportunities are identified as skills and strengths within the group are highlighted.

**ACTIVITIES:** Projects can be indoor or outdoor with tasks ranging from helping with clearing or repair work at a local nature reserve, completing a garden makeover at a school or residential facility, providing catering and entertainment for a local community group, clearing litter and tidying a communal area, painting and decorating, helping to install new furniture or facilities, or general building repairs.

**TIMINGS:** To suit the client – projects can be for a half day, full day or longer term.

**LOCATION:** We have details of a number of current projects. Please contact Fresh Tracks to find out if there is something in your area.

**COSTINGS:** Approx. £100 + VAT per participant depending on type of project. POA for large groups.

**NOTES:** This type of project varies enormously and can be tailored to suit the needs of the team. We would usually charge a research fee to research community activity options in your area. *Facilitation, if required, is charged at £1050 + VAT for a half day or £1900 + VAT for a full day.*
