RAT TRAP



- AIM:** A fun, fast and furious activity that builds on team cooperation as well as individual skills to achieve the common goal of creating a mechanical trap within a tight time scale to catch a rat.
- FORMAT:** Working in small teams, participants first have to build a crane to retrieve scrambled images of one or more mechanisms. Negotiating with other teams they swap images until they have a complete image of their mechanism. They then write an instruction manual for this mechanism before moving to another workstation and a new mechanism. Again, liaison and networking are essential as teams use each others' manuals to assemble and decorate their mechanism. Finally – with all teams working together - mechanisms must be put in the correct sequence so that the final mechanism triggers the trap to catch the rat.
- ACTIVITIES:** Creating a lifting device; Assembling components necessary for one mechanism; Creating an instruction manual, including a risk assessment; Building a mechanism and checking its operation with other teams; Decorating the mechanism to resemble its illustration; Assembling the mechanisms in sequence to catch the rat
- TIMINGS:** 90 minutes to full day.
- DRESS:** Casual, comfortable clothing
- LOCATION:** Hotels and Conference Centres throughout the UK
- COSTINGS:** £2160 for up to 12 participants; £160 per additional participant
